Dear Parents/Carers

Re Yr 11 & Sixth Form Mock Exams 2017

As you are aware, an important part of preparing students for their final GCSEs & GCE's, is for them to practice taking exams through sitting mock exams. **We have planned for all Year 11 students & Sixth Form to take mock exams between Monday 11th December 2017 and Thursday 21st December 2017. A copy of the schedule is printed overleaf. Please Note - Year 11 Art mocks will take place after the Christmas holiday.**

It is important students attend all of the exams they have been studying for, as it provides the school with crucial information about what areas of knowledge to target in the final run up to the exams, as well as providing the students an experience of what to expect during the final exams next summer.

Please note the start and finish times of each exam. Students are expected to arrive on time to the exam and may be refused entry if they arrive late.

Students must bring with them all appropriate equipment for the exam, including at least 2 black biro's. Their teachers will explain exactly what equipment to bring. Pencil cases must be transparent. If they are not, students must bring their equipment in a clear plastic bag. Students are also encouraged to bring water to the exam, but this must be in a clear plastic bottle with all labels removed.

Students are required to hand in their switched off mobile phones at the start of the exam. Please be advised that should a phone ring, beep, buzz or activate in anyway during the exam, even if it has been handed in, then the exam board reserve the right to cancel a student's paper. Please also note that smart watches will also have to be handed in. Any student wearing any other type of wristwatch, will be required to remove it and leave it on their exam desk during the exam.

The students have been fully briefed regarding the mock exam process, however should you or your son/daughter have any queries regarding mock exams, please speak to your son/daughter's form tutor in the first instance.
