Bedrock is an easy-to-use online system which challenges students' abilities in areas such as comprehension, grammar, and vocabulary. These vital skills are used by students in all subjects as well as being fundamental for communication which is essential for our student's well-being.

Throughout this term students in Key Stage 3 have had one lesson in their fortnightly timetable dedicated to Bedrock and we have received lots of positive feedback from them.
