'The Railway Children' at London Waterloo was staged in this way with the train track as the stage and the audience sitting on the platforms facing each other.

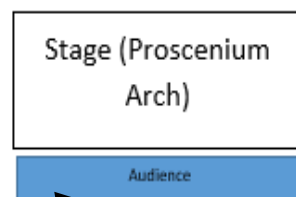
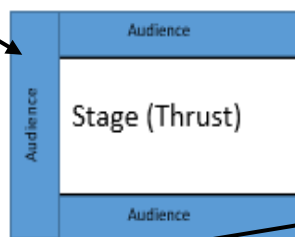
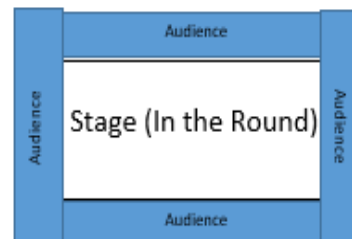
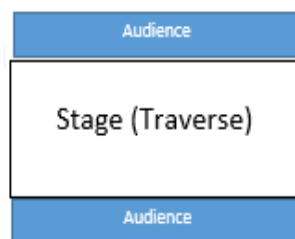
The actors have to work hard so that the audience see their faces. They must move around the stage regularly.

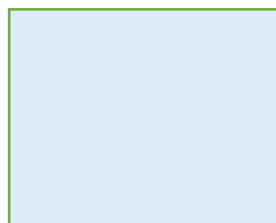
Vocal Tone	The way in which your voice changes to show your character's emotions

Vocal Volume	How loudly you speak when on stage and in character



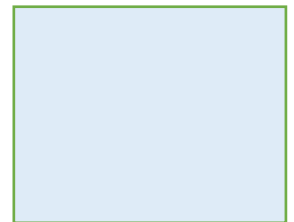
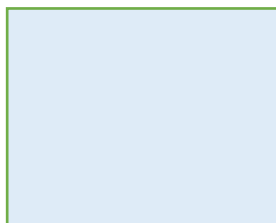
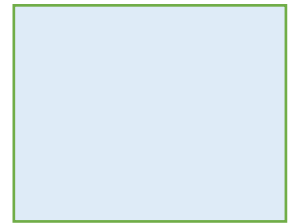
