<u>Epic Theatre</u> – Breaks the fourth wall, the imaginary wall between the actors and audience which keeps them as observers. They are active members of the theatrical experience as they are kept thinking throughout, not switching off.

<u>Verfremdungseffekt</u> – distancing the audience from an emotional attachment to instead focus on the message of the play. This message could be political, cultural or social.


