Girls (Year 7 to 11)

- ♦ Black blazer with embroidered motif
- ♦ White shirt

- ♦ Black skirt , tailored and made of non-stretch fabric to allow movement and no more that 3-4" above the knee. No short or tight skirts are permitted. TRNS emblem optional.

Shoes, smart black trainers, boots, closed back sandals	Flipflops or sliders, white trainers.
Skirts or dresses – length appropriate for workplace.	Short skirts or dresses that are deemed not appropriate for a place of work.
Smart black jeans or trousers	Ripped / frayed jeans or trousers, blue denim. Tracksuit bottoms or exercise clothing.
Tailored / fitted style shorts – length appropriate for workplace	Tailored / fitted style shorts – length appropriate for workplace. Any other shorts i.e. cycling shorts / jogger material.
