Blue and silver tie

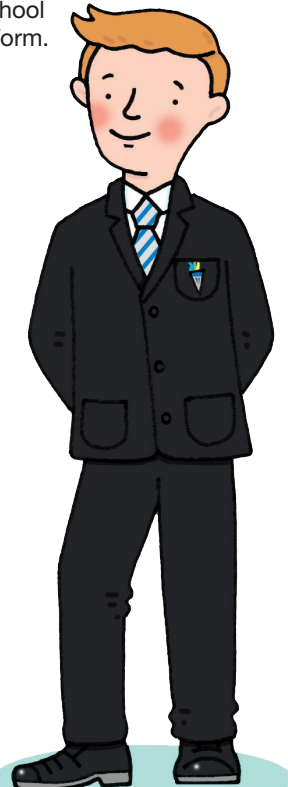
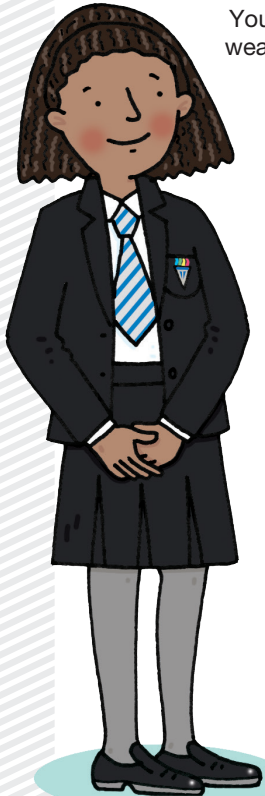
Plain black tailored trousers

Homework
